Chronic and Complex Community Nursing

This service is provided by Community Nurses either in their homes and/or Community Nursing Clinics.

- Persons with a chronic disease requiring care, management and integration of services
- Persons requiring wound management related to chronic disease, complex wounds, postsurgical and acute wounds
- Persons requiring continence assessment and management related to chronic disease
- Persons requiring supportive care and symptom management for oncology treatments
- Persons requiring a nursing procedure who are mobile and have access to transport will attend the local Community Nursing Clinic

Chronic and Complex Allied Health

This service is provided by Community Allied Health clinicians in their homes and Podiatry Clinics.

Podiatry

The Chronic and Complex podiatrists try to improve the foot health of people who are at risk of foot complications and our goal is to prevent hospitalisation and foot amputations. Podiatry care is delivered in one of our clinics or in the patient's home and it is provided to people with an identified clinical need, such as those with reduced blood flow to their feet and/or loss of feeling in their feet.

Physiotherapy

Provides a home visiting service to clients who cannot access a physiotherapy service outside their own home. Physiotherapy offers assessment, treatment and education for falls prevention, including home exercise programs to improve strength and balance, mobility issues, mobility aid recommendations, management of chronic lung diseases and functional activities to maintain independence at home.

Occupational Therapy

Provides a home visiting service which offers assessment of adults who are experiencing difficulties performing personal care and other functional activities, with independence and safety. Also prescribes appropriate aids and equipment and assists with planning home modifications.

Dietetics

Provides a home visiting service which offers nutrition information and support to assist in managing a variety of conditions such as: unintentional weight loss, pressure injuries and wounds, texture modified diets, diabetes, obesity and enteral feeding.

Speech Pathology

Provides a home visiting service which offers diagnostic assessment and treatment of speech, language, voice, communication, feeding and/or swallowing disorders.
